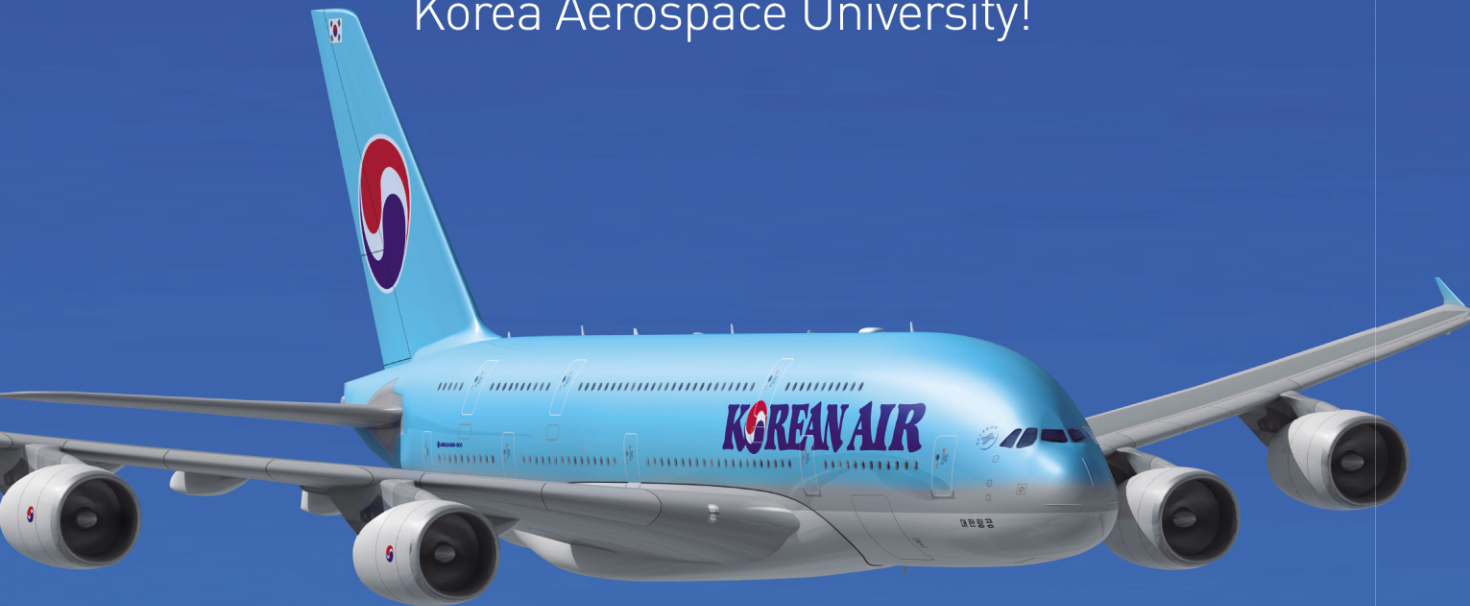

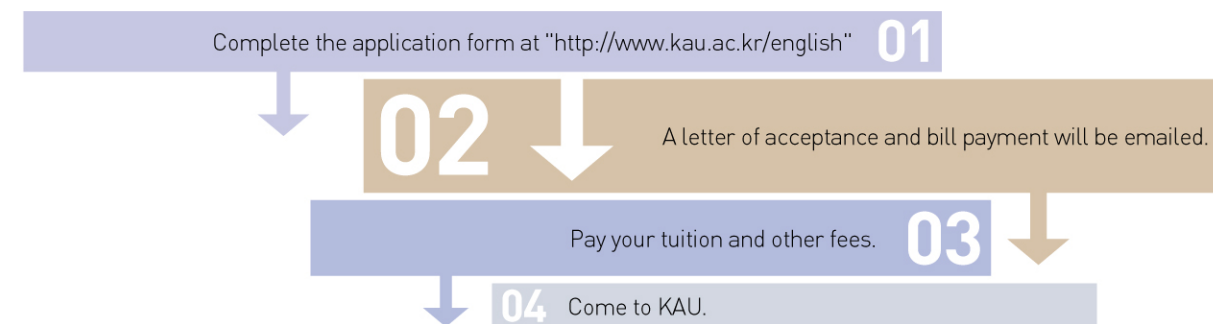

Korean Air

It serves 130 cities in 45 countries, and its domestic division serves 20 destinations. 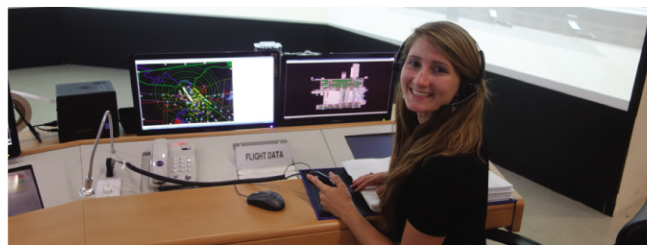

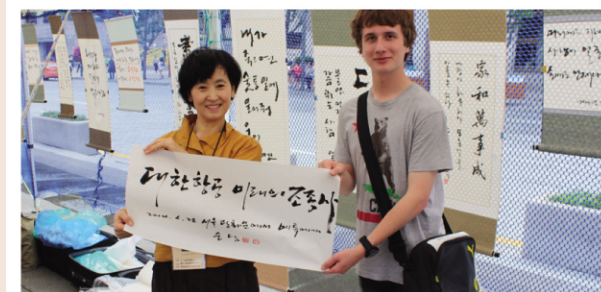
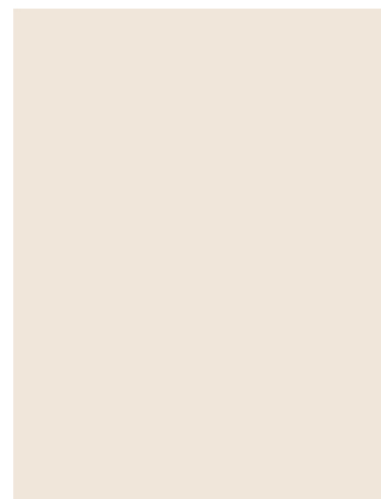
This is unpaid internship. Due to the highly competitive nature of the program, not all ISP applicants will be guaranteed a position. Nominees will be announced in the middle of the program.

Visa

If you are a newly-admitted international student currently outside of the Republic of Korea, you should apply for a suitable visa to participate in the ISP. Students from visa waiver countries can enter Korea without a visa as long as they stay in Korea no more than 90 days. Please refer to the KAU website (www.kau.ac.kr/english) to find out whether your country is a designated Visa-Free Entry country or a country that has a Visa Waiver Agreement with Korea.

Airport Pick-Up

KAU can provide you with an airport pick-up service from Incheon International Airport to campus for your convenience. The service fee is KRW 70,000(one way only) and you can apply for pick-up service on the application form. Please make sure that your flight arrival details are correctly written in your application form.

Health Insurance

Korea Aerospace University cares about the health and well-being of students and recognizes that staying healthy is vital to a successful summer experience. KAU provides health insurance to all international students enrolled in the ISP. The health insurance provided by KAU will cover accidents that are incurred in Korea from June 25 until July 24th, 2015. Students coming earlier or leaving later than the program must have their own travel insurance.
